

Poland (Krakow) - Interreg Europe: Environment

The Agricultural University of Krakow is looking for partners within the Interreg Europe program for the environment sector, in particular in reference to a greener Europe.

General objective

Build a new participatory decision-making process to prepare the spaces of river valleys for climatic changes that manifest themselves in periodic excess or deficit of water.

It will use the advanced and potential technologies of the partners in the field of habitat studies, ecophysiological studies, determination of water chemistry.

Recommendations for decision makers will be the result of the joint work of representatives of society, institutions and organizations.

The conclusions included in the final project document will promote activities in the field of flood disaster risk reduction and mitigation of the consequences of climate change.

With particular reference to the Drought Management Plan for River Basin Districts 2021-2027, the aim will be to:

- Adaptation to climate change
- disaster risk prevention
- resilience
- protection and conservation of nature and biodiversity
- green infrastructure
- reduction of pollution
