

Draft of the mobility project for professionals within the framework of Erasmus+

Improving qualifications project will be implemented under the new EU programme Erasmus+. This programme was launched in 2014 and will be continued until 2020. The Erasmus+ is designed to improve the quality and efficiency of qualifications and skills. The Erasmus+ Programme continues the tradition of , among others, the Leonardo da Vinci Programme.

THEME:

Voivodeship Labour Office in Katowice, Silesia (Poland) is going to present a mobility project for employees of the public employment services (managers of the local labour offices and Voivodeship Labour Office in Katowice, vocational advisors, programme specialists and people responsible for implementing European funds. The project is addressed to a group of 53 people who will take training abroad (participants will be divided into 4 groups of training).

This project is designed to improve the professionals skills of the public employment staff by getting familiar with solutions aimed at supporting the youth from NEET group (without education, employment, or training). It is to increase their activity in the labor market. In the EU countries the NEET youth is supposed to be one of the most problematic group in the context of the unemployed among young people. EU countries are obliged to take efficient actions regarding employment among the youth and there is an urgent need to start this project.

Voivodeship Labour Office in Katowice would like to invite to this cooperation institution that deals with job activation of the youth, in particular from NEET group and could cooperate with our office in this project by undertaking the role of the Host Organization for the project participants.

OBJECTIVES:

- obtain information on the situation of young people classified as NEET group in another EU country;
- become familiarized with instruments and services provided to increase economic activity participation of unemployed youth;
- become familiarized with good practice examples in the area of job activation;
- exchange of experiences and views on the integration of young people with the labor market;
- implementation of the idea of mutual learning and sharing of knowledge and experience.

BENEFICIARIES:

Beneficiaries of the exchange project will be the group of 53 people who manage institutions dealing with the unemployed, including the NEET group. In this group there will also be people who are dealing, on daily basis, with providing support in the context of career guidance, programme specialists and those responsible for implementing European funds,

including the programming of actions aimed at the integration of unemployed young people into the labor market. Participants will be the employees of public employment services from the Silesian Voivodship.

OUTCOMES:

- improving knowledge of participants about the situation of unemployed youth and activation measures for young people from NEET group;
- adapting effective activation solutions ,that are possible to be implemented in Silesia Region;
- establishing international cooperation and create conditions for the exchange of experiences and knowledge between organizations involved in the project.
