Training Course: Zoom in Interculturality with creativity to more tolerant Europe

Description of the project

The Training Course Zoom in Interculturality will gather 20 youth workers from 10 Programme countries with aim to increase quality and visibility of projects promoting intercultural understanding and tolerance. The project will take place in Slovakia and will last 7 days, the month of July. The project is composed of two parts. In first part will participants increase their own intercultural competencies, learn how to improve quality of intercultural learning in international projects through artistic and creative methods and exchange experiences and best practices in the field of intercultural learning. The second part will be practical and creative. Space will be given directly to participants. Youth workers will exchange their knowledge and experiences and put them in practice by working in small group on promotional videos, campaigns and events.

Main objectives

- To deepen knowledge about concepts of discrimination, prejudice and stereotypes, xenophobia and other forms of intolerance and their mechanism and to increase intercultural competencies of youth workers
- To empower youth workers with competencies to design and lead workshop on intercultural learning in the frame of non-formal education and to exchange tools and methods of intercultural learning
- To increase ability of youth workers in use of artistic and creative methods in youth work
- To exchange experience, strategies and methodologies in promotion of active tolerance and intercultural understanding
- To increase visibility of intercultural project through exchange of experiences in use of different promotional tools as video, photography or blog in order to increase visibility of projects

All the activities are design as open non-formal education and learning process based on participants' experience and exchange. Different methods will be used by trainers/facilitators to adapt the activities to different need and profile of participants and their learning style.

FINANCIAL CONDITION

Financial condition will follow the rules of the Erasmus+ Programme. Travel costs will be covered till the limit established by Erasmus+ distance calculator.
