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presentation of the association

The Club de Loisirs de Tourlaville is an association of Popular Education born in 1967. It has 2,300 members, a hundred active volunteers and 12 employees. It manages 3 poles (sports - childhood / youth and culture) and works on 4 structures spread over the territory of Tourlavillais. It conducts sociocultural and sports activities for all audiences without discrimination.

The aim of the association is to develop projects and promote the practice of activities in a spirit of popular education. It wishes to encourage meetings and cultural exchanges between all the target groups (children, adolescents, adults) from all cultural and socio-economic backgrounds.

The Tourlaville Leisure Club defends several axes in its associative project, which joins the priorities of the Erasmus + program:

- Axis 1: To be a place of learning of citizenship and democracy.

One of the objectives of this axis is to encourage young people to take responsibility. This takes into account the dimension of active participation of young people in projects.

- Axis 2: Being a key player in local life and territory. One of the objectives is to strengthen and develop institutional and associative partnerships, but also to be a place of innovation for the territory.

For many years, the CLT has been promoting encounters and discovering other cultures for children and adolescents. Several actions have already been put in place:

- Franco-Algerian exchanges (reception)

- European exchanges within the framework of the PEJA (3 receptions)

- European exchanges within the framework of Erasmus + (2 receptions and 2 departures)

The association also participates in intercultural actions carried out on the territory by partners to sensitize young people and animators to the process.

We take part in training courses and seminars set up in France and in the European Union. This allows facilitators to learn about intercultural issues and to meet potential future European partners.

Dans le cadre de l'Agenda 2030, Cherbourg en Cotentin s'est donné plusieurs objectifs et défis à mettre en œuvre :

- Organize the daily life of the exchange in a responsible and sustainable way (travel, materials, recycling ...)
- Fight against prejudices and stereotypes conveyed by the unknown
- Promote the intercultural meeting to improve the living together
- Leave room for initiatives proposed and promoted by young people and inhabitants

It is therefore around this approach that the project will focus to enable young people and residents to reflect and express themselves on the issues related to the sustainable development strategy, whether at the scale of the urban territory of Cherbourg in Cotentin than on a European scale.

Accompanied by their structure, the idea is also to allow young Europeans to think, to propose, to share ideas and concepts by valuing what is put in place in their respective countries.

The productions produced must be the result of collective and cooperative work, transferable to other partner countries for the purpose of educational tools for sustainable development.

The actions and tools that will be put in place will be defined with the European partners in order to respond to their local problems.

GENERAL OBJECTIVES

- Encourage exchange, reflection at the local and European level to sensitize citizens to consume responsibly.
- Promote living together and in intelligence: collaborate, co-build, produce, share, value, communicate.
- To discover other forms of entrepreneurship in the context of the social and solidarity economy.
- Allow young people to live an intercultural experience, to share and to have an active part, to be force proposals on the theme of sustainable development that take into account their local environment, in France and in the partner countries.

Roles of European partners approached in the project:

- Provide expertise and co-build the project by pooling resources, skills and means of action in an intercultural framework.
- To discover the actions considered and implemented in terms of sustainable development in their territory and more specifically on their structure.
- Collaborate in the construction of a local event, transposable on the territories of each European.

Final action:

- Highlight the productions of young people who take into account their ideas and thoughts on the theme of sustainable development
- Implement an event with strong local impact by mobilizing partners from the social and solidarity economy.
